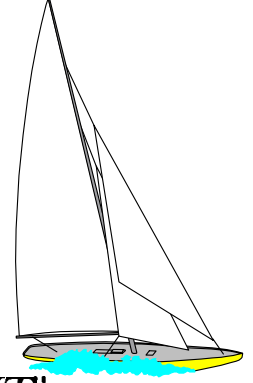


winterizing



'WINTERIZE TO PROTECT YOUR INVESTMENT'

It's that time of year again. A few basic steps can save you hundreds of dollars. Even though We live in the South, your boat needs to be protected from freezing conditions. This past January , some of your neighbors experienced the power of freezing water. We have had boats sink in our Marina and others on shore experienced damaged engines.

Attached is a Winterizing work sheet and links to Web sites to explain how to winterize and care for your boat over the cool months.

Also if you have an owners manual, Please read & heed the the appropriate section on caring for your particular boat. Not all boats are the same.

SOME POINTS TO REMEMBER

1. DON'T USE AUTO ANTI-FREEZE "ITS POISON" USE THE NON-TOXIC ANTI-FREEZE IN ALL FRESH WATER APPLICATIONS.
2. TOP OFF BATTERY'S & FULLY CHARGE.
3. IN WATER STORAGE CLOSE ALL SEA VALVES. (TRU-HULL)
4. REMEMBER ENGINES WITH A THERMOSTAT HAVE TO BE BROUGHT UP TO OPERATING TEMPERATURE WHEN WINTERIZING.
